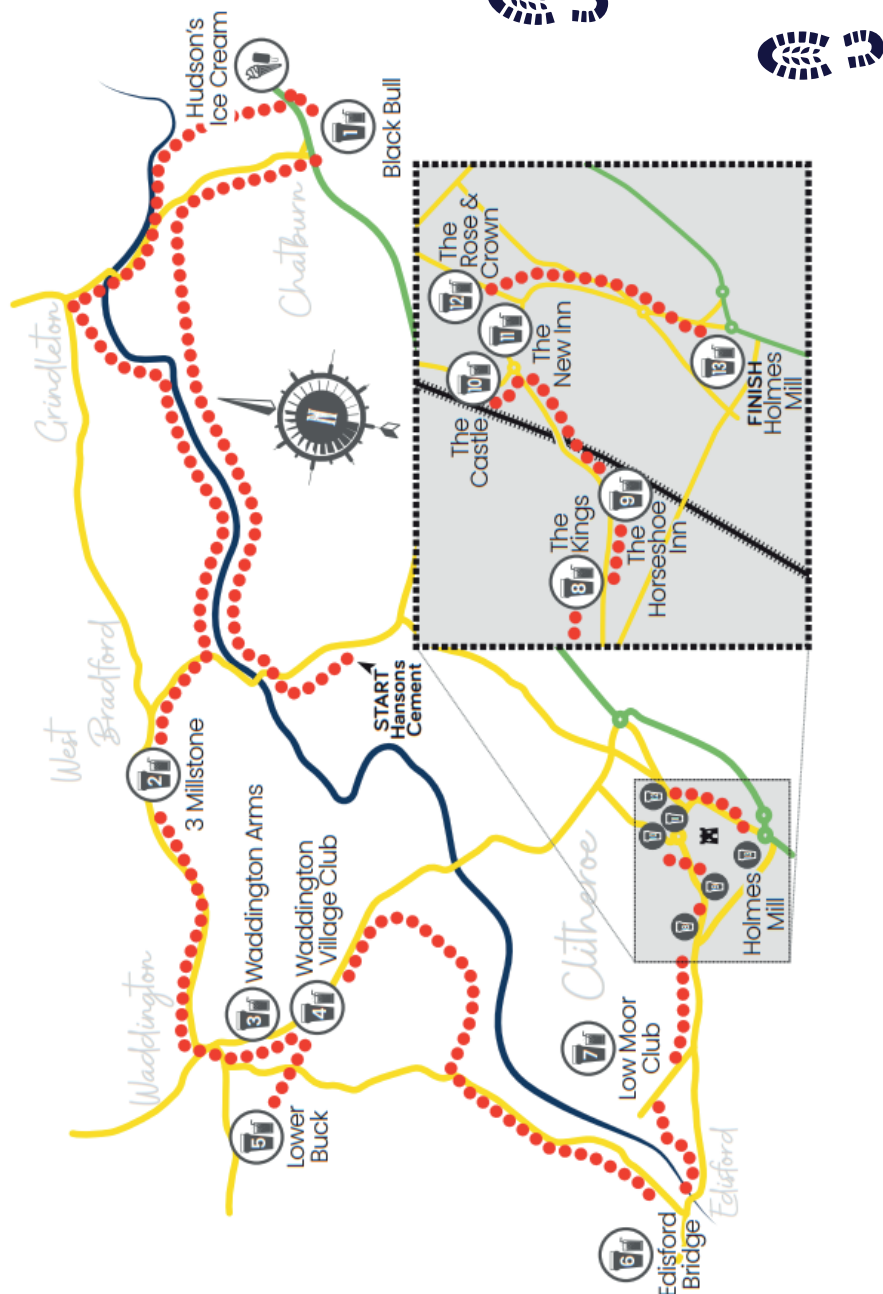

Where to go

From the car park at Hanson's Cement, walk down the hill at the bridge.

- 📍 Walk through the gate and along the river bank towards Chatburn; walk for approx. 1.5 miles, turning right onto a tree-lined path adjacent to the road.
- Continue for 0.5 mile into Chatburn village.
- Turn left at the T junction, for approximately 10 minutes, passing the library and WC.
- Turn left, walking between the church and primary school through the field and down to the river, turn left walking along the river for approximately 1.5 miles onto the road.
- Turn right across the bridge, walk approximately 200 metres and turn left at the T junction.
- Turn left after 50 metres at the public footpath sign and down to the river.
- Turn right, walk along the river for approximately 2 miles, eventually coming out onto the road.
- Turn right into the village of West Bradford.
- Walk approximately 200 metres and then turn left at Millstreet Road, walking approximately 50 metres.
- Turn right to walk along the back of the houses bordering the stream then turn left at the end of the path and left over a stile and into the field.
- Continue through the field for approximately 1.5 miles passing a large green slurry tank bearing right towards the road, follow the footpath behind the back of a derelict house and onto the road turning right towards Waddington.
- Turn left at the T junction, continue walking for approximately 1.5 miles passing the entrance to Waddow Hall and over the bridge.
- Turn right at the stile and along the river bank towards Edisford Bridge and Low Moor Club and onto the T junction, turning left passing the Spar shop.
- Continue walking for approximately 0.5 mile, straight on over the mini roundabout and passing Clitheroe Castle on your right.
- 📍 Continue up the hill, turning right at the T junction, head straight on over the mini roundabout, turn right into Holmes Mill and Finish.
