



Stadium Sleep Out – Terms & Conditions

By registering to take part in the Stadium Sleep Out event, you agree to abide by the following terms and conditions:

1. Alcohol & Drug Policy

- Alcohol may be purchased from Coley's Bar during the quiz night.
- No alcohol is to be taken outside of the premises or brought into the designated sleep out area.
- Wham Stadium is a non-smoking venue, anyone who wishes to smoke/vape must do so in the designated area.
- East Lancashire Hospice and Accrington Stanley Community Trust do not tolerate the use of drugs. If anyone participant is found with the possession of illegal drugs, the organisers have the right to take legal action.
- Organisers reserve the right to remove any participant from the event if they are deemed to be intoxicated and/or causing disruption.

2. Age Restrictions

- Participants must be aged 14 or over.
- Participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a participating adult, who will be fully responsible for their supervision and welfare throughout the event.

3. Fundraising Commitment

- The event supports both East Lancashire Hospice and Accrington Stanley Community Trust.

- By registering, you agree to raise a minimum of £100 in sponsorship, which will be equally divided between the two charities (50% each).
- Wham Stadium is a cashless venue, if you are purchasing drinks on the night please ensure that this is a contactless payment method.

4. Health & Safety

- First aiders will be on-site and available between 8:00 PM on Friday 10th October 2025, until 6:00 AM on Saturday 11th October 2025.
- In the event of a serious emergency, participants must contact the Emergency Services by calling 999.
- East Lancashire Hospice and Accrington Stanley Community Trust accept no liability for any illness or injuries that may result from sleeping outside in cold weather conditions.
- If for any reason you need to leave during the event, please let a member of security know for safeguarding purposes.
- By registering, you acknowledge and accept the risks associated with sleeping outdoors in potentially cold weather.

5. Sleeping Equipment

- All participants are responsible for bringing their own sleeping kits as outlined in the event Welcome Pack.

6. Clean-Up

- All participants must tidy their belongings and ensure that the Accrington Stanley Wham Stadium is left clean and litter-free at the end of the event.

7. Weather Conditions

- The event will go ahead in most weather conditions. In the event of extreme or unsafe weather, the organisers reserve the right to cancel, postpone, or alter the event format.
- Any changes will be communicated via email and/or the event's official social media channels.

8. Code of Conduct

- All participants are expected to behave respectfully towards other attendees, volunteers, staff, and stadium property.
- Aggressive, abusive, or discriminatory behaviour of any kind will result in removal from the event.

9. Photography and Media Consent

- By attending the event, you consent to being photographed or filmed. These images may be used in promotional materials for East Lancashire Hospice, Accrington Stanley Community Trust, and affiliated media.

10. Valuables and Personal Belongings

- Participants are responsible for their own belongings. The organisers will not be held liable for any lost, stolen, or damaged items.
- It is recommended not to bring valuables to the event.

11. Toilet and Facility Access

- Toilet facilities will be available throughout the event. Participants are expected to respect and keep these areas clean.

12. Parking and Transport

- Parking is available at the stadium.
- No overnight sleeping is permitted in vehicles.

13. Health Guidelines

- Participants agree to follow any current public health advice or event-specific guidance in place at the time of the event.
- If you are feeling unwell or experiencing symptoms of illness, please do not attend.
